



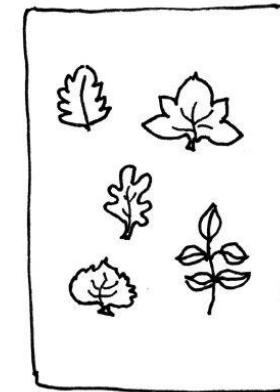
Memory, Bingo or Pairs Games



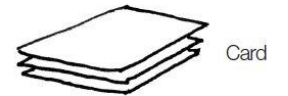
- ❑ Cut out or photocopy images from magazines of leaves and common weeds
- ❑ Stick them on to card and laminate if you can
- ❑ Turn pictures face down, two of each picture, mixing them up well
- ❑ Play pairs or use as a memory game, by asking a question when they make a pair, for example “What type of tree is this leaf from?”, “What is the name of this flower” or “Is this edible?”

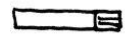
- Photocopiable Images
